## Notice from South Gloucestershire Council

### Public Footpath LBA/2 Badminton (temporary prohibition of Use by Foot Passengers) Order 2025

Notice is hereby given that South Gloucestershire District Council in pursuance of the provisions of section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended intends to make an order the effect of which will be to close, temporarily, to foot passengers that length of Public Footpath LBA/2 which extends from its junction with Badminton Road/Well Lane in a southerly direction to a point 117 metres north of its junction with Shop Lane.

This order is required for the following reason: in connection with the likelihood of danger to the public consequent upon building and deconstruction works. The order will be operative from 1 April 2025 for a maximum period of eighteen months. The closure however may not be implemented for the whole of the period but only when traffic signs are in position and only for so long as is necessitated by the works which are anticipated to be of **7 weeks** duration.
