At the time of going to print it would appear our water supply is back to normal albeit some residents may be on reduced pressure for a short period of time.

Having spoken to Bristol Water they confirmed they can offer a service to help customers with particular needs during similar incidents where we have no water. Their website states that if you have additional needs due to age, ill health, a disability, mental illness or particular needs you can register for Priority Services; their team can then take this into account. Their Priority Services register means they can identify and respond quickly if you need extra care.
