Ash Dieback

Badminton Estates are felling in the Coombes and the contractors' vehicles are instructed to use Starveall Lane. The Estate is embarking on a continuing programme of removing diseased trees, leaving the understory as much as possible and replanting with Oak, Beech, Hornbeam and other indigenous varieties. All works are approved by the Forestry Commission with the appropriate licences, and executed by accredited contractors.

No Mow May

Hawkesbury Parish Council is supporting No Mow May to help restore nature in response to the Climate and Nature Emergency. It was decided to select “The Plain” and not have this area of land cut, to let it grow for just four weeks. This campaign is organised by Plantlife which helps support biodiversity by asking people not to mow their lawn or a part of it during the month of May. This is a critical time of year to support insects and birds and to increase flowers and plants for the benefit of people and wildlife.
